

#### More Choices in Airlines to Come Soon in Viet Nam

Currently, the only major airlines doing business in Viet Nam are Air France, Japan Airlines, Korean Air, Southern China Airlines, Cathay Pacific and Eva Airlines. However, that will soon change, because according to Vietnam Civil Aviation Administration, several major airlines have applied for open sevices in Viet Nam. Those airlines include: Luara Air, Northwest, Continental, Delta, and United.

billion dollars (that's \$6,000,000,000) plus is expected to pour into Viet Nam from foreign investment this year, and there's more to come. With rapid growth and expansion, and an abundance of natural resources, Viet Nam is likely to attract major foreign capital investment through the end of the century. Already this year the first U.S. oil refinery (estimated at \$1.1 Billion) is under construction as well as a \$600 million port in Sao Am-Ben Dinh. Other big projects include numerous thermo/gas power plants.

#### With Openness Comes the Press?

In the past decade we've seen Viet Nam transform itself from an isolated country with deep rooted beliefs in communism to a more open country. With democracy comes a willingness to allow people to read, share, and discuss issues without fear of retribution. This is evident in the number of press agents, which represent both local and national newspapers.
